A. Pay Stub	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -DC tax withholding for current tax year -Issued within the past 45 days
B. Unexpired letter confirming financial assistance from the DC Government Ex. TANF, Medicaid, DC Alliance, Supplemental Security Income	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Issued within the past 12 months
C. Certified copy of DC Tax Form D40	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Certified by DC Office of Tax and Revenue -Evidence of payment of DC taxes for prior tax year
D. Embassy letter to prove the applicant lives on embassy property	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Issued within the past 12 months -Embassy address -Official embassy seal
OR	
IF YOU CANNOT provide one of the documents of above, you may bring TWO (2) ORIGINALS of the following:	
E. Unexpired DC motor vehicle registration	
F. Unexpired lease or rental agreement & 1 receipt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Receipt of payment of rent within the past 2 months
G. Unexpired DC driver's license or other official DC ID	
H. One utility bill & 1 receipt (only gas, electric, and water bills are acceptable)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Receipt of payment for the utility bill within the past 2 months
